



**Bethune-Cookman University-Higher Education Emergency Relief

1. An acknowledgement that the institution signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used, or intends to use, the applicable amount of funds designated Section 314(a)(1) of the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA) to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.

On March 08, 2021, the Bethune-Cookman University acknowledged receipt of supplemental funding under CRRSAA. Furthermore, BCU intends to use no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 314(a)(1) of the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA) to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

2. The total amount of funds that the institution has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA programs.

The University has received a total of \$3,324,251 of which \$3,324,251 was **issued directly** to students for Emergency Financial Aid Grants.

3. The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under the CRRSAA programs as of the date of submission (i.e., as of the initial report and every calendar quarter thereafter).

As of December 31, 2021, the total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants **distributed** to students are \$3,324,251.

4. The estimated total number of students at the institution that were eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA programs.

BCU had 2,999 students that were **eligible** to receive funds under guidance provided by the Department of Education.

5. The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under the CRRSAA programs.

As of December 31, 2021, a total of 2,999 students have received funds under this award.

6. The method(s) used by the institution to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants and how much they would receive under the CRRSAA programs.

Consistent with Department of Education guidelines, all active students enrolled during the 2020-2021 academic year were eligible to apply for HEERF II funds. BCU prioritized students with exceptional needs or have faced significant unexpected expenses that would affect their financial situation. This priority group also included students who were unable to cover an outstanding balance.

7. Any instructions, directions, or guidance provided by the institution to students concerning the Emergency Financial Aid Grants.
