



Housing Agreement Acknowledgment

Student/resident hereby acknowledges that he or she has read this Housing and Residence Life License, the agreement application, addendum(s), and the Rules and Regulations. Student/resident understands that the Rules and Regulations may be amended from time to time. This process is to verify the validity of the signing applicant. Notaries are typically found in local US Postal Offices, banks, or county clerk offices. Failure to follow this procedure will result in a delay of room reservation. Improper notarization or signing deems this agreement and housing application incomplete and therefore cannot be processed.
